This workshop is for you!

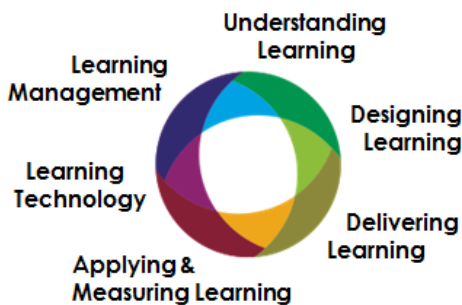
The morning session on **Understanding Learning Foundations** will cover the following:
